Know Your Rights

There are many reasons why you may need to access RUSU Student Rights...

- Are accused of plagiarism or being discriminated against
- Have been recommended for 'Exclusion' or identified as 'At Risk'
- Have a complaint which is being ignored or dismissed as 'not important'
- Have been denied 'Special Consideration'
- Have enrolment or fee issues
